- 2/13 units have dedicated respite care nurse
- 2 centres have charity funded babysitting service

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Define roles of specialist nurses
- Review competencies
- Establish number of specialist nurses and their caseloads
- Establish what we are unable to achieve
- What staff we need to achieve standards

Recommendations for staffing

- Inpatients 1: 3
- Additional nurse (in charge)
- Care supervised by Registered Children's nurse with ENB 147
- Transplantation
- 1:1 48 hours post operatively
- 1 : 50 Care by outreach nurse

Staffing Recommendations

- Haemodialysis 1:1 < 5 years or special needs
- 1 : 1 > 5 years
- Acute extra corporeal treatments 1 : 1 care by Registered Children's Nurse with ENB 147
- Peritoneal dialysis 1 : 10 outreach care
- Pre dialysis 1 : 30 outreach care
